Operating Instructions – Working with deep freezer (Eppendorf cryocube) According to Occupational Health and Safety Regulation

Hazards for people and the environment



Risk of explosion

Lethal voltages inside the device

Damage to health due to infectious liquids and pathogenic germs.

Risk of fire due to escaping flammable refrigerants (R-170 and R-290) Device warms up fast.





Protective measures and rules of behaviour

Wear cold protection gloves when loading and unloading the device.

Minimising the opening time. Therefor you should know where you samples are.

Label your samples precise and sign in the related file with name date and content-readable.

Do not operate the device in areas where work with explosive substances is carried out.

Do not store explosive or highly reactive substances in the device.

Do not use the device to store substances that may generate an explosive atmosphere.

Do not store any aerogenic substances in the device, e.g., dry ice.

Ensure that the housing is closed and undamaged.

Do not remove the housing.

Ensure that no liquids can penetrate the device.

If the supplied mains/power cord is defective, replace it with a mains/power cord and a plug of the same type.

Ensure adequate ventilation of the location.

Label you samples detailed and sign in the related file with name date and content.

Call 5555 if the freezer has reached -74°C degrees.

Behaviour in case of danger

Inform the person responsible for the area immediately in the event of faults! Switch off the machine!



In case of fire: Keep calm!

Call the fire department on 112! Inform the central control room on 55112!

Warn employees!

Fight the fire with a CO2 extinguisher! Pay attention to self protection!
