VolumeShare 7 • Quick Reference Guide

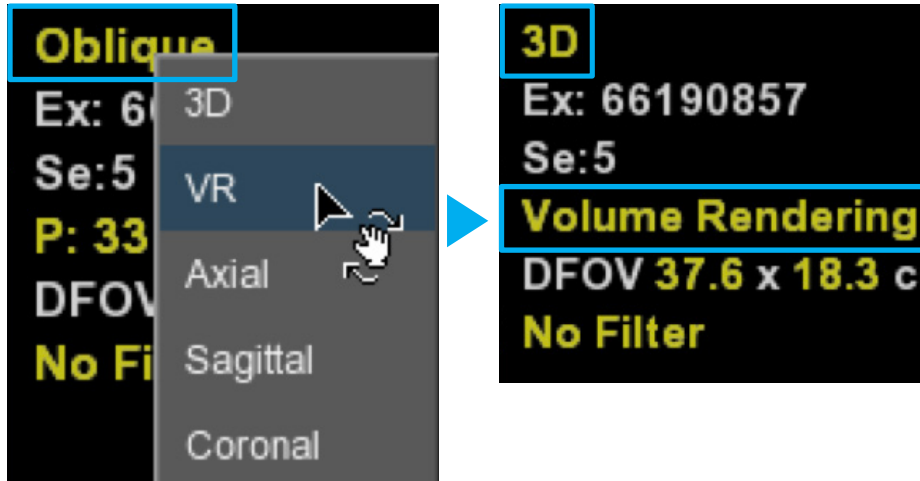
3D printing is a Volume Viewer functionality enabling the user to export a segmented volume into an STL format compatible with 3D printers.

1. Load exam

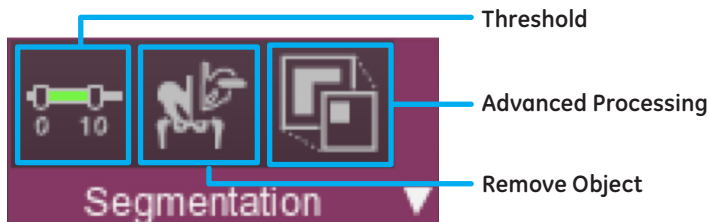
In **Volume Viewer** (Reformat/Volume Rendering/VV General Review/...)

2. Create VR

- **Display a Volume Rendering (VR)** in one of the viewports. (Click on view type and select VR from the list)



- **Segment** the VR:
Use the **segmentation tools** to make sure only pixels you wish to export are present in the viewport. (Sometimes some pixels are not displayed but are still present in the volume. Ex: skin)
Use the Threshold, Remove Object, Advanced Processing tools from the Segmentation toolbar.



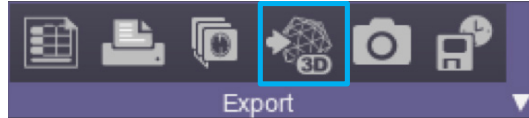
- **VR Settings tools** can also be used to edit the VR if needed. (Refer to the Volume Viewer user guide for more information)



Note: The volume does not have to be a VR to be exported in STL, as long as it has been segmented (3D, segmented axial/ coronal/sag,...)

3. Export VR

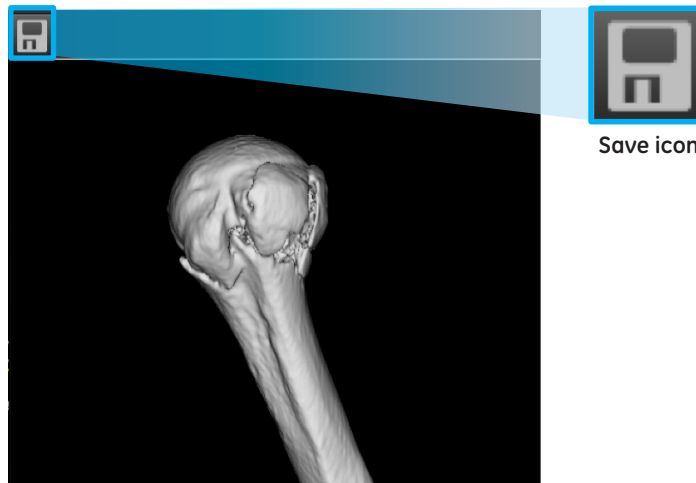
- Select the **STL Export icon** from the Export tool menu.



- Click on **segmented volume** to export.



The created STL model will be displayed in a new window.



- Click and drag to rotate and **check** the **model**.
- Insert a USB stick into a USB port and use the **Save** icon to save the model to the **USB** stick.

Note: VR colors are not exported. Print colors, materials and scalability are based on the specifications of the 3D printer.
